International Competition Bidding - Invitation

The National Directorate of Administration and Finance, at the Ministry of Justice invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the **Supply and Delivery of Food for Becora Prison in Díli, Timor-Leste – Lot 1**. The contract will be funded from current year budget appropriations of The Government of Timor-Leste.

1. Bidding will be undertaken by Invitation To Bid, with the participation of a *bona fide* Suppliers for the **Supply and Delivery of Food**.
2. **The Bids must be received in the Tender Box located at Ministry of Justice, Rua da Justiça, Colmera, Díli Timor-Leste, from 28 January until 03 February 2021, no later than 15:00 hours local Time**, late Bids for the will be reject. **On February 3, 15:00 hours** the box should be opened in the presence of bidders who wish to attend the opening.
3. Bidding will be conducted as a **two envelopes** procedure: the **Technical Proposal** (containing the bid security document) and the **Financial Proposal (price bid)** that shall be submitted together but in separated envelopes and sealed as specified in section 1 Instruction to Bid. Bid that has a different price structure for the Financial Proposal shall not be considered.
4. A Pre-bid meeting will be held at **15:00 PM local time on 27 January 2021** in the Conference Room of Ministry of Justice, Colmera, Díli, Timor-Leste. The Pre-bid Meeting referred is required.
5. **Bid Security-** Bidders are also required to provide a bid security. The Bid Security is at the amount of US \$5.000. The bid security shall be on demand irrevocable bank guarantee made out to the Government of Timor-Leste. All bids received without a bid security will not be considered after the deadline of submission of bids and the company will be excluded of the competition.
6. **Bid Evaluation-** the tender assessment criteria is provided at Bidding documents, section III, which is to combine the technical and financial score at weight of 40:60, respectively, after meet all the requirements in first stage. A judge nominated will conduct the evaluation.
7. **Guarantees-** Prior to the signing of the Contract, the winner of the bid shall be required to provide a Performance Guarantee which is 5% of the price of contract. The performance guarantee might be a bank guarantee, made out to the Government of Timor-Leste. The winner shall also provide the Guarantee of Quality through discounts in future payments and considering period longer than the contract. **Contract will not be awarded to the bidders who are unable to provide the two types of guarantees before signing the contract.**
8. The bidders can purchase documents from Tuesday **22 January until 29 January 2021 at 09.00 AM until 16:00 PM local time**, and may be purchased for a non-refundable fee of USD \$20.00 at the address specified on number 2. or at the website www.mj.gov.tl. which can be downloaded until 3 February 2021 for free.


Section I. Instructions to Bidders

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A. General

- 1. Scope of Bid**
- 1.1 In support of the Invitation for Bids indicated in the Bid Data Sheet (BDS), the Employer, as indicated in the BDS, issues this Bidding Document for the Supply and delivery of 26 items of food alimentary for an average of 600 prisoners at Becora Prison in Dili. Becora Prison will prepare 3 daily meals for each one of them. The goods and services as specified in Section V, Price and Delivery Schedule of supply. The name and identification of the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) are provided in the BDS.
- 1.2 Throughout this Bidding Document:
- (a) the term “in writing” means communicated in written form with proof of receipt;
 - (b) if the context so requires, singular means plural and vice versa; and
 - (c) “day” means calendar day.
- 2. Source of Funds**
- 2.1 The Employer has allocated funds from its current budget year appropriations toward the cost of the supply Food Alimentary for Prisoners in Becora Prison. The Employer intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible payments under the contract for which this Bidding Document is issued.
- 3. Corrupt Practices**
- 3.1 The Employer requires the bidders to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contract. In pursuance of this policy, the Employer:
- (a) defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:
 - (i) “corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, anything of value to influence improperly the actions of another party;
 - (ii) “fraudulent practice” means any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;
 - (iii) “coercive practice” means impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence improperly the actions of a party;
 - (iv) “collusive practice” means an arrangement between two or more parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including influencing improperly the actions of another party;
 - (b) will reject a bid for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract;
 - (c) will sanction a party or its successor, including declaring ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to participate in Employer-financed activities if it at any time determines that the firm has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for, or in executing, an Employer-financed contract, and will have the right to inspect the bidder’s accounts and



- records and other documents relating to the Bid submission and contract performance and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Employer; and
- 4. Eligible Bidders and post qualification requirements**
- 4.1 A Bidder may be a natural person, private entity, or any combination of them with a formal intent to enter into an agreement or under an existing agreement in the form of a Joint Venture (JV). In the case of a JV:
- (a) all parties to the JV shall be jointly and severally liable; and
 - (b) a JV shall nominate a Representative who shall have the authority to conduct all businesses for and on behalf of any and all the parties of the JV during the bidding process and, in the event the JV is awarded the Contract, during contract execution.
- 4.2 The Employer considers a conflict of interest to be a situation in which a party has interests that could improperly influence that party's performance of official duties or responsibilities, contractual obligations, or compliance with applicable laws and regulations. The Employer will take appropriate actions if it determines that a conflict of interest has flawed the integrity of any procurement process. Consequently all Bidders found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A Bidder may be considered to be in a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process if, including but not limited to:
- (a) have controlling shareholders in common; or
 - (b) receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy from any of them; or
 - (c) have the same legal representative for purposes of this Bid; or
 - (d) have a relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the Bid of another Bidder, or influence the decisions of the Employer regarding this bidding process; or
 - (e) a Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all Bids in which it is involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the same subcontractor, not otherwise participating as a Bidder, in more than one bid; or
- 4.3 A firm that is under a declaration of ineligibility by the Employer in accordance with ITB 3, at the date of the deadline for bid submission or thereafter, shall be disqualified.
- 4.4 Bidders shall provide such evidence of their continued eligibility satisfactory to the Employer, as the Employer shall reasonably request.
- 4.5 For post qualification requirements:
- a) Post qualification shall be based on data contained in the Purchaser's Vendor Information Form and supporting documentation for concerned Supplier, provided that such information shall have been submitted or updated by the Supplier within the three months previous to Bid submission;
 - b) for post qualification, bidders must also provide:



- Supplier's Responsible Personnel (signed by firm's owner or Chief Executive);
- evidence of sufficient working capital for this contract including lines of available credit and availability of other financial resources;
- a current bank statement;
- authority for the Purchaser to seek references from the bidder's bankers.

The Employer will respond in writing to any request for clarification, provided that such request is received no later than ten (10) days prior to the deadline for submission of Bids. The Employer shall forward copies of its response to all Bidders who have acquired the Bidding Document directly from it, including a description of the inquiry but without identifying its source. Should the Employer deem it necessary to amend the Bidding Document as a result of a clarification, it shall do so following the procedure under ITB Clause 7 and Sub-Clause 21.2.</p> |
| 7. Amendment of Bidding Document | <p>7.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of the Bids, the Employer may amend the Bidding Document by issuing addenda.</p> |

- 7.2 Any addendum issued shall be part of the Bidding Document and shall be communicated in writing to all who have obtained the Bidding Document directly from the Employer.
- 7.3 To give prospective Bidders reasonable time in which to take an addendum into account in preparing their Bids, the Employer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of the Bids, pursuant to ITB Sub-Clause 21.2


C. Preparation of Bids

- 8. Cost of Bidding** 8.1 The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid, and the Employer shall not be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.
- 9. Language of Bid** 9.1 The Bid, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Bid exchanged by the Bidder and the Employer, shall be written in the language specified in the BDS. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Bid may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the language specified in the BDS, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Bid, such translation shall govern.
- 10. Documents Comprising the Bid**
- 10.1 The Bid shall comprise two envelopes submitted simultaneously, one containing the Technical Bid and the other the Price Bid, enclosed together in an outer single envelope.
- 10.2 Initially, only the Technical Bids are opened at the address, date and time specified in ITB Sub-Clause 24.1. The Price Bids remain sealed and are held in custody by the Employer. The Technical Bids are evaluated by the Employer. No amendments or changes to the Technical Bids are permitted. Bids with Technical Bids which do not conform to the specified requirements will be rejected as deficient Bids.
- 10.3 The Price Bids of the Bidders with the top two technical scores will be opened in public at a date and time advised by the Employer. The Price Bids are evaluated and the Contract is awarded to the Bidder who got the highest score in the combined technical and financial evaluations.
- 10.4 The Technical Bid shall contain the following :
- (a) Technical Bid Submission Sheet;
 - (b) Bid Security, in accordance with ITB Clause 18;
 - (c) written confirmation authorizing the signatory of the Bid to commit the Bidder, in accordance with ITB Clause 19;
 - (d) documentary evidence in accordance with ITB Clause 15 establishing the Bidder's eligibility to bid;
 - (e) documentary evidence in accordance with ITB Clause 16 establishing the Bidder's qualifications to perform the contract if its Bid is accepted; and
 - (f) any other document required in the BDS.
- 10.5 The Price Bid shall contain the following:
- (a) Price Bid Submission Sheet and the applicable Price Schedules, in accordance with ITB Clauses 11, 13, and 14;
 - (b) alternative Price Bid corresponding to the alternative Technical



- Bid, if permissible, in accordance with ITB Clause 12; and
- (c) any other document required in the BDS.
- 11. Bid Submission Sheets and Price Schedules**
- 11.1 The Bidder shall submit the Technical Bid and the Price Bid using the appropriate Submission Sheets furnished in Section IV, Bidding Forms. These forms must be completed without any alterations to their format, and no substitutes shall be accepted. All blank spaces shall be filled in with the information requested.
- 11.2 The Bidder shall submit, as part of the Price Bid, the Price Schedules for the Services, using the forms furnished in Section IV, Bidding Forms.
- 12. Alternative Bids**
- 12.1 Unless otherwise indicated in the BDS, alternative bids shall not be considered.
- 13. Bid Prices and Discounts**
- 13.1 The prices and discounts quoted by the Bidder in the Price Bid Submission Sheet and in the Price Schedules shall conform to the requirements specified below.
- 13.2 All items in the Schedule of Supply must be listed and priced separately in the Price Schedules. If no price is quoted for an item in the Price Schedule, the price shall be assumed to be included in the prices of other items.
- 13.3 The price to be quoted in the Price Bid Submission Sheet excluding any discounts offered.
- 13.4 The Bidder shall quote any unconditional discounts and the methodology for their application in the Price Bid Submission Sheet.
- 13.5 Prices quoted by the Bidder shall be fixed during the Bidder's performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account, unless otherwise specified in the BDS. A Bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation shall be treated as nonresponsive and shall be rejected, pursuant to ITB Clause 27. However, if in accordance with the BDS, prices quoted by the Bidder shall be subject to adjustment during the performance of the Contract, a Bid submitted with a fixed price quotation shall not be rejected, but the price adjustment shall be treated as zero.
- 13.6 Bidders can only submit one sealed financial proposal. In respect to the price schedule bidders can chose for option 1 or option 2 in order to respond to the specification, in both scenarios, bidders can fill two options of price shedule. Both the options of price shall have the same total price bid using only the designated format for submitting quotes and offers.
- 14. Currencies of Bid**
- 14.1 The unit rates and the prices shall be quoted by the bidder entirely in the currency specified in the BDS.
- 15. Documents Establishing the Eligibility of the Bidder**
- 15.1 To establish their eligibility in accordance with ITB Clause 4, Bidders shall:
- (a) complete the eligibility declarations in the Bid Submission Sheet, included in Section IV, Bidding Forms; and
- (b) if the Bidder is an existing or intended JV in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 4.1, submit a copy of the JV Agreement, or a letter of intent to enter into such an Agreement. The respective document shall be signed by all legally authorized signatories of all the parties to the existing or intended JV, as appropriate.

- 16. Documents Establishing the Qualifications of the Bidder**
- 16.1 To establish its qualifications to perform the Contract, the Bidder shall submit as part of its Technical Bid the evidence indicated for each qualification criteria specified in Section III, Evaluation and Qualification Criteria.
- 17. Period of Validity of Bids**
- 17.1 Bids shall remain valid for the period specified in the BDS after the bid submission deadline date prescribed by the Employer. A Bid valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the Employer as nonresponsive.
- 17.2 In exceptional circumstances, prior to the expiration of the bid validity period, the Employer may request Bidders to extend the period of validity of their Bids. The request and the responses shall be made in writing. If a Bid Security is requested in accordance with ITB Clause 18.1, it shall also be extended for a corresponding period. A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its Bid Security. A Bidder granting the request shall not be required or permitted to modify its Bid.
- 18. Bid Security**
- 18.1 Unless otherwise specified in the BDS, the Bidder shall furnish as part of its bid, in original form, a Bid Security as specified in the BDS. The amount shall be as specified in the BDS.
- 18.2 The Bid Security shall be, at the Bidder's option, in any of the following forms:
- (a) a bank guarantee;
- all from a reputable bank from an eligible country. In case of a bank guarantee, the Bid Security shall be submitted using the Bid Security Form included in Section IV, Bidding Forms, or another form acceptable to the Employer. The form must include the complete name of the Bidder. The Bid Security shall be valid for twenty-eight days (28) beyond the end of the validity period of the bid. This shall also apply if the period for bid validity is extended.
- 18.3 If a Bid Security is required in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 18.2, any Bid not accompanied by a substantially responsive Bid Security in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 18.3, shall be rejected by the Employer as nonresponsive.
- 18.4 The Bid Security of unsuccessful Bidders shall be returned as promptly as possible upon the successful Bidder furnishing the Performance Security pursuant to ITB 36 and ITB Clause 37.
- 18.5 The Bid Security of successful Bidder shall be returned as promptly as possible once the successful Bidder has signed the Contract and furnished the required Performance Security.
- 18.6 The Bid Security may be forfeited:
- (a) if a Bidder withdraws its Bid during the period of bid validity as specified in ITB Clause 17.1, except as provided in ITB Sub-Clause 17.2; or
- (b) if the successful Bidder fails to :
- (i) Sign the Contract in accordance with ITB Clause 39;
- (ii) Furnish a Performance Security in accordance with ITB Clause 37; or



- (iii) accept the correction of its Bid Price pursuant to ITB Clause 28.

18.7 The Bid Security of a JV must be in the name of the JV that submits the bid. If the JV has not been legally constituted at the time of bidding, the Bid Security shall be in the names of all future partners as named in the letter of intent mentioned in ITB Sub-Clause 15.1.

**19. Format and
Signing of Bid**

19.1 The Bidder shall prepare one original of the Technical Bid and one original of the Price Bid as described in ITB Clause 10 and clearly mark each "ORIGINAL - TECHNICAL BID" and "ORIGINAL - PRICE BID". In addition, the Bidder shall submit copies of the Technical Bid and the Price Bid, in the number specified in the BDS and clearly mark them "COPY NO... - TECHNICAL BID" and "COPY NO.... - PRICE BID". In the event of any discrepancy between the original and the copies, the original shall prevail.

19.2 The original and all copies of the Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the Bidder. This authorization shall consist of a written confirmation as specified in the BDS and shall be attached to the Bid. The name and position held by each person signing the authorization must be typed or printed below the signature. All pages of the Bid, except for unamended printed literature, shall be signed or initialled by the person signing the Bid.

19.3 Any interlineations, erasures, or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialled by the person signing the Bid.

D. Submission and Opening of Bids

**20. Sealing and
Marking of Bids**

20.1 The Bidder shall enclose the original of the Technical Bid, the original of the Price Bid, and each copy of the Technical Bid and each copy of the Price Bid, including alternative bids, if permitted in accordance with ITB Clause 12, in separate sealed envelopes, duly marking the envelopes as "ORIGINAL - TECHNICAL BID", "ORIGINAL - PRICE BID" and "COPY NO... - TECHNICAL BID" and "COPY NO.... - PRICE BID", as appropriate. These envelopes containing the original and the copies shall then be enclosed in one single envelope.


20.2 The inner and outer envelopes shall:

- (a) bear the name and address of the Bidder;
- (b) be addressed to the Employer in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 21.1; and
- (c) bear the specific identification of this bidding process indicated in the BDS.

20.3 The outer envelopes and the inner envelopes containing the Technical Bids shall bear a warning not to open before the time and date for the opening of Technical Bids, in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 24.1.

20.4 The inner envelopes containing the Price Bids shall bear a warning not to open until advised by the Employer in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 24.2.

20.5 If all envelopes are not sealed and marked as required, the Employer will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the bid.



- 20.6 Alternative Bids, if permissible in accordance with ITB Clause 12, shall be prepared, sealed, marked, and delivered in accordance with the provisions of ITB Clauses 19 and 20, with the inner envelopes marked in addition "ALTERNATIVE NO...." as appropriate.
- 21. Deadline for Submission of Bids**
- 21.1 Bids must be received by the Employer at the address and no later than the date and time indicated in the BDS.
- 21.2 The Employer may, at its discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of Bids by amending the Bidding Document in accordance with ITB Clause 7, in which case all rights and obligations of the Employer and Bidders previously subject to the deadline shall thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.
- 22. Late Bids**
- 22.1 The Employer shall not consider any Bid that arrives after the deadline for submission of Bids, in accordance with ITB Clause 21. Any Bid received by the Employer after the deadline for submission of Bids shall be declared late, rejected, and returned unopened to the Bidder.
- 23. Withdrawal, Substitution, and Modification of Bids**
- 23.1 A Bidder may withdraw, substitute, or modify its Bid after it has been submitted by sending a written Notice, duly signed by an authorized representative, and shall include a copy of the authorization in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 19.2 (except that withdrawal notices do not require copies). The corresponding substitution or modification of the bid must accompany the respective written notice. All Notices must be:
- (a) submitted in accordance with ITB Clauses 19 and 20 (except that Withdrawal Notices do not require copies), and in addition, the respective inner and outer envelopes shall be clearly marked "Withdrawal," "Substitution," "Modification"; and
 - (b) received by the Employer prior to the deadline prescribed for submission of bids, in accordance with ITB Clause 21.
- 23.2 Bids requested to be withdrawn in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 23.1 shall be returned unopened to the Bidders.
- 23.3 No Bid shall be withdrawn, substituted, or modified in the interval between the deadline for submission of bids and the expiration of the period of bid validity specified in ITB Clause 17.1 or any extension thereof.
- 24. Bid Opening**
- 24.1 The Employer shall conduct the opening of Technical Bids in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at the address, date and time specified in the BDS.
- 24.2 The Price Bids will remain unopened and will be held in custody of the Employer until the time of opening of the Price Bids. The date, time, and location of the opening of Price Bids will be advised in writing by the Employer. If the Technical Bid and the Price Bid are submitted together in one envelope, the Employer may reject the Bid. Alternatively, the Price Bid may be immediately resealed for later evaluation.
- 24.3 First, envelopes marked "WITHDRAWAL" shall be opened, read out, and recorded, and the envelope containing the corresponding Bid shall not be opened, but returned to the Bidder. No Bid shall be withdrawn unless the corresponding Withdrawal Notice contains a valid authorization to request the withdrawal and is read out and recorded at bid opening.
- 24.4 Next, outer envelopes marked "SUBSTITUTION" shall be opened. The inner envelopes containing the Substitution Technical Bid and/or



Substitution Price Bid shall be exchanged for the corresponding envelopes being substituted, which are to be returned to the Bidder unopened. Only the Substitution Technical Bid, if any, shall be opened, read out, and recorded. Substitution Price Bids will remain unopened in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 24.2. No envelope shall be substituted unless the corresponding Substitution Notice contains a valid authorization to request the substitution and is read out and recorded at bid opening.

24.5 Next, outer envelopes marked "MODIFICATION" shall be opened. No Technical Bid and/or Price Bid shall be modified unless the corresponding Modification Notice contains a valid authorization to request the modification and is read out and recorded at the opening of Technical Bids. Only the Technical Bids, both Original as well as Modification, are to be opened, read out, and recorded at the opening. Price Bids, both Original as well as Modification, will remain unopened in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 24.2.

24.6 All other envelopes holding the Technical Bids shall be opened one at a time, and the following read out and recorded :

- (a) the name of the Bidder;
- (b) whether there is a modification or substitution;
- (c) the presence of a Bid Security, if required; and
- (d) any other details as the Employer may consider appropriate.

Only Technical Bids and alternative Technical Bids read out and recorded at bid opening shall be considered for evaluation. No Bid shall be rejected at the opening of Technical Bids except for late bids, in accordance with ITB Sub-Clause 22.1.

24.7 The Employer shall prepare a record of the opening of Technical Bids that shall include, as a minimum: the name of the Bidder and whether there is a withdrawal, substitution, modification, or alternative offer; and the presence or absence of a Bid Security, if one was required. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall be requested to sign the record. The omission of a Bidder's signature on the record shall not invalidate the contents and effect of the record. A copy of the record shall be distributed to all Bidders.

24.8 **In accordance with the applicable law, the Employer shall open the Price Bids of only the Bidders with the top two technical scores based on the result of the Technical Evaluation.**


24.9 At the end of the evaluation of the Technical Bids, the Employer will invite **the Bidders with the top two technical scores** to attend the opening of the Price Bids. The date, time, and location of the opening of Price Bids will be advised in writing by the Employer. Bidders shall be given reasonable notice of the opening of Price Bids.

24.10 The Employer will notify Bidders in writing who have been rejected and return their Price Bids unopened.

24.11 The Bidder's representatives who are present shall be requested to sign a register evidencing their attendance.

24.12 The envelopes containing Price Bids of the **Bidders with the top two technical scores** shall be opened one at a time and the following read out and recorded:

- (a) the name of the Bidder
- (b) whether there is a modification or substitution;



(c) the Bid Prices, including any discounts and alternative offers; and

(d) any other details as the Employer may consider appropriate.

Only Price Bids, discounts, and alternative offers read out and recorded during the opening of Price Bids shall be considered for evaluation. No Bid shall be rejected at the opening of Price Bids.

- 24.13 The Employer shall prepare a record of the opening of Price Bids that shall include, as a minimum: the name of the Bidder, the Bid Price (per lot if applicable), any discounts, and alternative offers. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall be requested to sign the record. The omission of a Bidder's signature on the record shall not invalidate the contents and effect of the record. A copy of the record shall be distributed to all Bidders.







Section III. Evaluation and Qualification Criteria

The evaluation shall be based on the documents that the Bidder has submitted with its Bid. Therefore, the Bidder is reminded to submit all the necessary information and documentation to enable the Purchaser to make an evaluation. Failure of the Bidder to provide the necessary information may result in the rejection of the Bid.

Bid evaluation shall be undertaken in two stages. If one bidder is placed first in both lots then, the evaluation process may include three stages. The first stage will be the Evaluation of Technical Bids applying the technical evaluation criteria, subcriteria, and scoring system specified below. The maximum technical score is 500 points and **the passing score for bidder qualification is 350 points.**

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
1. Definitions

1.1 The following words and expressions shall have the meanings hereby assigned to them:

- (a) "Contract" means the Agreement entered into between the Employer and the Food Supplier, together with the Contract Documents referred to therein, including all attachments, appendices, and all documents incorporated by reference therein.
- (b) "Contract Documents" means the documents listed in the Agreement, including any amendments thereto.
- (c) "Contract Price" means the price payable to the Food Supplier as specified in the Agreement, subject to such additions and adjustments thereto or deductions therefrom, as may be made pursuant to the Contract.
- (d) "Day" means calendar day.
- (e) "Delivery" means the transfer of the Foods from the Food Supplier to the Employer in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract.
- (f) "Completion" means the fulfillment of the Related Services by the Food Supplier in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract.
- (g) "GCC" means the General Conditions of Contract.
- (h) "Foods" means all of the foods that the Food Supplier is required to supply to the Employer under the Contract.
- (i) "Employer's Country" is the country specified in the Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).
- (j) "Employer" means the entity purchasing the Foods and Related Services, as specified in the SCC.
- (k) "Related Services" means the services incidental to the supply of the Foods, such as support personnel during delivery and maintaining the food in an acceptable condition and other similar obligations of the Food Supplier under the Contract.
- (l) "SCC" means the Special Conditions of Contract.
- (m) "Subcontractor" means any natural person, private or government entity, or a combination of the above, including its legal successors or permitted assigns, to whom any part of the Foods to be supplied or execution of any part of the Related Services is subcontracted by the Food Supplier.
- (n) "Food Supplier" means the natural person, private or government entity, or a combination of the above, whose bid to perform the Contract has been accepted by the Employer and is named as such in the Agreement, and includes the legal successors or permitted assigns of the Food Supplier.
- (o) "The Site," where applicable, means the location named in the SCC.

2. Contract Documents

2.1 Subject to the order of precedence set forth in the Agreement, all documents forming the Contract (and all parts thereof) are intended to be correlative, complementary, and mutually explanatory.



3. Corrupt Practices

3.1 The Employer requires Bidders and Food Suppliers to observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contract. In pursuance of this policy, the Employer:

- (a) defines, for the purposes of this provision, the terms set forth below as follows:
 - (i) "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, anything of value to influence improperly the actions of another party;
 - (ii) "fraudulent practice" means any act or omission, including a misrepresentation, that knowingly or recklessly misleads, or attempts to mislead, a party to obtain a financial or other benefit or to avoid an obligation;
 - (iii) "coercive practice" means impairing or harming, or threatening to impair or harm, directly or indirectly, any party or the property of the party to influence improperly the actions of a party;
 - (iv) "collusive practice" means an arrangement between two or more parties designed to achieve an improper purpose, including influencing improperly the actions of another party;
- (b) will reject a bid for award if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract; and
- (c) will sanction a firm or an individual, including declaring ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to participate in Employer -financed activities if it at any time determines that the firm or individual has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive or other prohibited practices.

3.2 The Food Supplier shall permit the Employer to inspect the Food Supplier's accounts and records relating to the performance of the Food Supplier and to have them audited by auditors appointed by the Employer, if so required by the Employer.

4. Interpretation

4.1 If the context so requires it, singular means plural and vice versa.

4.2 Entire Agreement


The Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the Employer and the Food Supplier and supersedes all communications, negotiations and agreements (whether written or oral) of parties with respect thereto made prior to the date of Contract.

4.3 Amendment

No amendment or other variation of the Contract shall be valid unless it is in writing, is dated, expressly refers to the Contract, and is signed by a duly authorized representative of each party thereto.

4.4 Nonwaiver

- (a) Subject to GCC Sub-Clause 4.5(b) below, no relaxation, forbearance, delay, or indulgence by either party in enforcing any of the terms and conditions of the Contract or the granting of time by either party to the other shall prejudice, affect, or



restrict the rights of that party under the Contract, neither shall any waiver by either party of any breach of Contract operate as waiver of any subsequent or continuing breach of Contract.

- (b) Any waiver of a party's rights, powers, or remedies under the Contract must be in writing, dated, and signed by an authorized representative of the party granting such waiver, and must specify the right and the extent to which it is being waived.

4.5 Severability

If any provision or condition of the Contract is prohibited or rendered invalid or unenforceable, such prohibition, invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provisions and conditions of the Contract.

5. Language

- 5.1 The Contract as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the Contract exchanged by the Food Supplier and the Employer, shall be written in the language specified in the SCC. Supporting documents and printed literature that are part of the Contract may be in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate translation of the relevant passages in the language specified in the SCC, in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the Contract, this translation shall govern.

- 5.2 The Food Supplier shall bear all costs of translation to the governing language and all risks of the accuracy of such translation.

6. Joint Venture, Consortium or Association

- 6.1 Unless otherwise specified in the SCC, if the Food Supplier is a joint venture, consortium, or association, all of the parties shall be jointly and severally liable to the Employer for the fulfillment of the provisions of the Contract and shall designate one party to act as a leader with authority to bind the joint venture, consortium, or association. The composition or the constitution of the joint venture, consortium, or association shall not be altered without the prior consent of the Employer.

7. Eligibility


- 7.1 In terms of eligible source countries for supply of Foods and related services. The Employer currently has no specific restrictions.
- 7.2 For the purpose of this Clause, origin means the country where the Foods have been grown, mined, cultivated, produced, or processed.

8. Notices

- 8.1 Any Notice given by one party to the other pursuant to the Contract shall be in writing to the address specified in the SCC. The term "in writing" means communicated in written form with proof of receipt.
- 8.2 A Notice shall be effective when delivered or on the Notice's effective date, whichever is later.

9. Governing Law

- 9.1 The Contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Employer's country, unless otherwise specified in the SCC.
- 9.2 In the event of and as soon as possible after the occurrence of any cause constituting force majeure, the Supplier shall give notice and full particulars in writing to the Purchaser of such occurrence or change if the Supplier is thereby rendered unable, wholly or in part, to perform its obligations and meet its responsibilities under the Contract.



- 9.3 The Supplier shall also notify the Purchaser of any other changes in conditions or the occurrence of any event, which interferes or threatens to interfere with its performance of the Contract. On receipt of the notice required under this Article, the Purchaser shall take such action as, in its sole discretion, it considers to be appropriate or necessary in the circumstances, including the granting to the Supplier of a reasonable extension of time in which to perform its obligations under the Contract.
- 9.4 If the Supplier is rendered permanently unable, wholly, or in part, by reason of force majeure to perform its obligations and meet its responsibilities under this Contract, the Purchaser shall have the right to suspend or terminate the Contract.
- 9.5 The Supplier shall not be liable for liquidated damages if and to the extent that its delay in performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the Contract is the result of Force Majeure.
- 10. Settlement of Disputes**
- 10.1 The Employer and the Food Supplier shall make every effort to resolve amicably by direct informal negotiation any disagreement or dispute arising between them under or in connection with the Contract.
- 10.2 If the parties fail to resolve such a dispute or difference by mutual consultation within twenty-eight (28) days from the commencement of such consultation, either party may require that the dispute be referred for resolution to the formal mechanisms specified in the SCC.
- 11. Scope of Supply**
- 11.1 Subject to the SCC, the Foods and Related Services to be supplied shall be as specified in Section V, Schedule of price and supply.
- 11.2 Unless otherwise stipulated in the Contract, the Scope of Supply shall include all such items not specifically mentioned in the Contract but that can be reasonably inferred from the Contract as being required for attaining Delivery and Completion of the Foods and Related Services as if such items were expressly mentioned in the Contract.
- 12. Delivery and validity**
- 12.1 Subject to GCC Sub-Clause 21.1, the Delivery of the Foods shall be in accordance with the location, kind and quantity of food, time of delivery and the requirements specified in Section V, Schedule of Supply. The Supplier shall correct defects in the delivery process otherwise the warranty will be executed.
- 12.2 The contract shall be in force as mentioned in SCC.
- 12.3 In case of delay in delivery, the fees will be 1% per day.
- 13. Food Supplier's Responsibilities, packing and liquidity of damages**
- 13.1 The Food Supplier shall supply all the Foods and Related Services included in the Price Schedule in accordance with GCC Clause 11.
- 13.2 The Supplier shall provide such packing of the Goods as is required to prevent their damage or deterioration during transit to their final destination.
- 13.3 Late delivery shall be subject, without notice, to an assessment of liquidated damages equivalent to the daily amount and maximum



amounts specified in the Special Conditions of Contract. The Purchaser has the right to deduct this amount from the supplier's outstanding invoices, if any. This remedy is without prejudice to any others that may be available to the Purchaser, including termination of the Contract, for the Supplier's non-performance, breach and/or violation of any of the terms and conditions of the Contract.

- 13.4 Acceptance of Goods delivered late shall not be deemed a waiver of the Purchaser's rights to hold the Supplier liable for any loss and/or damage resulted therefrom, nor shall it act as a modification of the Supplier's obligation to make future deliveries in accordance with the delivery schedule

14. Employer's Responsibilities

- 14.1 Whenever the supply of Foods and Related Services requires that the Food Supplier obtain permits, approvals, and obtaining visas for thier own personnel, the Employer shall, if so required by the Food Supplier, make its best effort to assist the Food Supplier in complying with such requirements in a timely and expeditious manner.
- 14.2 The Food Supplier shall pay all costs involved in the performance of its responsibilities, in accordance with GCC Sub-Clause 14.1.

15. Contract Price

- 15.1 The Contract Price shall be as specified in the Agreement subject to any additions and adjustments thereto, or deductions therefrom, as may be made pursuant to the Contract.
- 15.2 Prices charged by the Food Supplier for the Foods delivered and the Related Services performed under the Contract shall not vary from the prices quoted by the Food Supplier in its bid, with the exception of any price adjustments authorized in the SCC.


16. Terms of Payment

- 16.1 The Contract Price shall be paid as specified in the SCC.
- 16.2 The Food Supplier's request for payment shall be made to the Employer in writing, accompanied by invoices describing, as appropriate, the Foods delivered and Related Services performed, and by the documents submitted pursuant to GCC Clause 12 and upon fulfillment of all the obligations stipulated in the Contract.
- 16.3 Payments shall be made promptly by the Employer, no later than sixty (60) days after submission of an invoice or request for payment by the Food Supplier, and the Employer has accepted it and in case of late, the fees will be 1% per day delay.
- 16.4 The currency or currencies in which payments shall be made to the Food Supplier under this Contract shall be specified in the SCC.

17. Taxes and Duties

- 17.1 For Foods supplied from outside the Employer's country, the Food Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, stamp duties, license fees, and other such levies imposed within the Employer's country.
- 17.2 For Foods supplied from within the Employer's country, the Food Supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, license fees, etc., incurred until delivery of the contracted Foods to the Employer.

- 17.3 If any tax exemptions, reductions, allowances or privileges may be available to the Food Supplier in the Employer's Country, the Employer shall use its best efforts to enable the Food Supplier to benefit from any such tax savings to the maximum allowable extent.
- 18. Performance Security and Guarantee of Quality**
- 18.1 The Food Supplier shall, within twenty-eight (28) days of the notification of Contract award, provide a Performance Security for the due performance of the Contract in the amounts and currencies specified in the SCC.
- 18.2 The proceeds of the Performance Security shall be payable to the Employer as compensation for any loss resulting from the Food Supplier's failure to complete its obligations under the Contract.
- 18.3 The Performance Security shall be denominated in the currencies of the Contract, or in a freely convertible currency acceptable to the Employer, and shall be in one of the forms stipulated by the Employer in the SCC, or in another form acceptable to the Employer.
- 18.4 The Performance Security is valid during the period of contract and shall be discharged by the Employer and returned to the Food Supplier not later than twenty eight (28) days following the date of completion of the Food Supplier's performance obligations under the Contract, including any warranty obligations, unless specified otherwise in the SCC.
- 18.5 A commercial warranty shall be applicable to the supplied goods and/ or related services, for the period and form specified in the Bid Data.
- 19. Subcontracting**
- 19.1 The Food Supplier shall notify the Employer in writing of all subcontracts awarded under the Contract if not already specified in the Bid. Subcontracting shall in no event relieve the Food Supplier from any of its obligations, duties, responsibilities, or liability under the Contract.
- 19.2 Subcontracts shall comply with the provisions of GCC Clauses 3 and 7.
- 20. Change in Laws and Regulations**
- 20.1 Unless otherwise specified in the Contract, if after the date of the Invitation for Bids, any law, regulation, ordinance, order or bylaw having the force of law is enacted, promulgated, abrogated, or changed in the place of the Employer's country where the Site is located (which shall be deemed to include any change in interpretation or application by the competent authorities) that subsequently affects the Contract Price, then such Contract Price shall be correspondingly increased or decreased, to the extent that the Food Supplier has thereby been affected in the performance of any of its obligations under the Contract. Notwithstanding the foregoing, such additional or reduced cost shall not be separately paid or credited if the same has already been accounted for in the price adjustment provisions where applicable, in accordance with GCC Clause 15.
- 21. Change Orders and Contract Amendments**
- 21.1 The Employer may at any time order the Food Supplier through Notice in accordance GCC Clause 8, to make changes within the general scope of the Contract in any one or more of the following:
- (a) the kind and quantity of the food;
 - (b) the place of delivery; and



(c) the Related Services to be provided by the Food Supplier.

21.2 If any such change causes an increase or decrease in the cost of, or the time required for, the Food Supplier's performance of any provisions under the Contract, an equitable adjustment shall be made in the Contract Price or in the Delivery and Completion Schedule, or both, and the Contract shall accordingly be amended. Any claims by the Food Supplier for adjustment under this Clause must be asserted within twenty-eight (28) days from the date of the Food Supplier's receipt of the Employer's change order.

21.3 Prices to be charged by the Food Supplier for any Related Services that might be needed but which were not included in the Contract shall be agreed upon in advance by the parties and shall not exceed the prevailing rates charged to other parties by the Food Supplier for similar services.

22. Termination

22.1 Termination for Default

(a) The Employer, without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of Contract, by Notice of default sent to the Food Supplier, may terminate the Contract in whole or in part:

- (i) if the Food Supplier fails to deliver any or all of the Foods within the period specified in the Contract; or
- (ii) if the Food Supplier fails to perform any other obligation under the Contract.

(b) In the event the Employer terminates the Contract in whole or in part, pursuant to GCC Clause 22.1(a), the Employer may procure, upon such terms and in such manner as it deems appropriate, Foods or Related Services similar to those undelivered or not performed, and the Food Supplier shall be liable to the Employer for any additional costs for such similar Foods or Related Services. However, the Food Supplier shall continue performance of the Contract to the extent not terminated.

(c) if the Food Supplier, in the judgment of the Employer has engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices, as defined in GCC Clause 3, in competing for or in executing the Contract.


22.2 Termination for Insolvency

The Employer may at any time terminate the Contract by giving Notice to the Food Supplier if the Food Supplier becomes bankrupt or otherwise insolvent. In such event, termination will be without compensation to the Food Supplier, provided that such termination will not prejudice or affect any right of action or remedy that has accrued or will accrue thereafter to the Employer.

22.3 Termination for Convenience

(a) The Employer, by Notice sent to the Food Supplier, may terminate the Contract, in whole or in part, at any time for its convenience. The Notice of termination shall specify that termination is for the Employer's convenience, the extent to which performance of the Food Supplier under the Contract is terminated, and the date upon which such termination becomes effective.

(b) The Foods that are complete and ready for shipment within fifteen (15) days after the Food Supplier's receipt of the




Notice of termination shall be accepted by the Employer at the Contract terms and prices. For the remaining Foods, the Employer may elect:

- (i) To have any portion completed and delivered at the Contract terms and prices; and/or
- (ii) to cancel the remainder and pay to the Food Supplier an agreed amount for partially completed Foods and Related Services and for materials and parts previously procured by the Food Supplier.

23. Assignment

- 23.1 Neither the Employer nor the Food Supplier shall assign, in whole or in part, their obligations under this Contract, except with prior written consent of the other party.
- 23.2 The Contract shall be signed at the presence of both parties in the day, local and time which the Employer will notify to the Food Supplier, or the successful Bidder shall sign, date, and return it to the Employer.



GCC 10.2	The formal mechanism for the resolution of disputes shall be: The rules of procedure for arbitration proceedings pursuant to GCC Clause 10.2 shall be as follows: (a) Contract with foreign Food Supplier: All disputes arising in connection with the present Contract the parties elect the Court of Díli to settle any dispute with express waiver of any other.
